David Bleich, University of Rochester, Wins 2015 CCCC Outstanding Book Award

Urbana, IL – February 2, 2015 – David Bleich, University of Rochester, has won a 2015 CCCC Outstanding Book Award in the Monograph category for his book, *The Materiality of Language: Gender, Politics, and the University*. The Conference on College Composition and Communication (CCCC) is a constituent organization within the National Council of Teachers of English (NCTE).

This award honors books within the field of composition and rhetoric. Single and multiple authored books, as well as edited volumes, are evaluated for scholarship and research in the areas of pedagogy, practice, history, and theory that make a significant contribution to the profession.

Bleich will be announced as a recipient of the CCCC Outstanding Book Award on March 20, during the 2015 CCCC Annual Convention in Tampa, Florida.
