

## CEL Representative to the Secondary Section Steering Committee

The CEL Liaison to the Secondary Section is elected by members of the Secondary Section of NCTE. (CEL Bylaws, Article III, Section 2).

The CEL Nominating Committee shall present a slate of two candidates to the CEL Executive Committee at the fall meeting, as necessary. Each nominee must have been a member of CEL and of the Secondary Section for at least two years and must have a history of active involvement in CEL. A new liaison to the NCTE Secondary Section shall be elected every four years by members of the Secondary Section.

In 1991, the Conference for Secondary School English Department Chairpersons (CSSEDC) changed its name to the Conference on English Leadership (CEL).
